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Korea Christian International School (KCIS) is a private, Christian school established in 2003, in the Ilsan area of Goyang City. KCIS emphasizes community service, and by the end of a KCIS high school career, every KCIS student will have completed in excess of 100 hours of community service.

The school prioritizes small teacher to student ratios and small classroom environments for optimal academic interaction. A highly rigorous college preparatory curriculum, regularly scheduled chapel services, comprehensive extracurricular activities program, and strong Christian honor code form the foundation of school life. If a student chooses to do so, the Schubert Pre-Medical graduation program offers the opportunity to enroll in Pécs Medical School in Europe, after graduation.

KCIS is fully accredited from The National Council for Private School Accreditation (NCPSA) by Accreditation International (A.I.). The school has been designated as an official ACT Test Center in Korea (Test Code No. 870980).

KCIS has currently enrolled 144 students from grades 7 through 12, and the majority are fluent in both English and Korean. All our graduates will attend a post-secondary school. At Korea Christian International School, students are able to experience personal and spiritual growth, maturing into capable international leaders ready to interact with and adapt to the ever-changing global community.

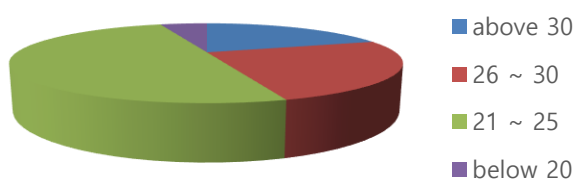

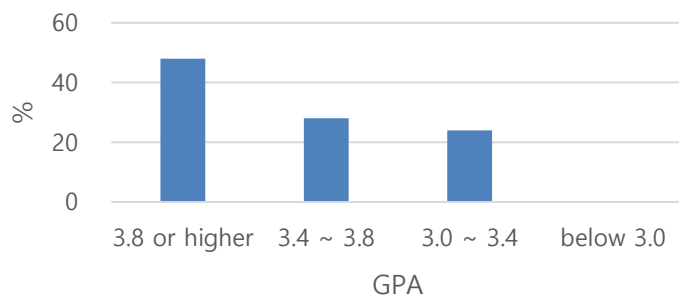

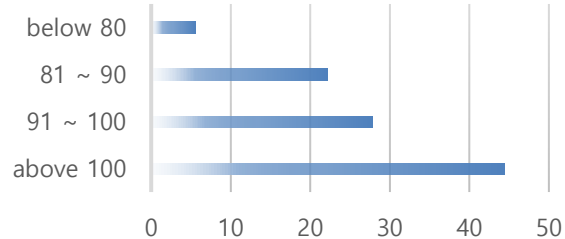
